Model 1

Inside School Building PK-8th, High School Students Virtual Learning

- Timeframe to serve breakfast and lunch in classroom to lengthen instructional time
- Prepackaged meals: no offer-versus serve
- Ask state department to remain under COVID-19 status (all meals will be at no cost to students)
- Class attendance daily to know how many meals to prepare if eating in classroom
- Deliver entire meal in t-shirt bags in classroom for students in the building and meals sent to virtual learning students
- If serving hot meals, need mobile electric holding cabinets (In building only)
- All employees will deploy meals to classrooms and bus delivery for virtual students
- If students come to cafeteria, need staggered times to ensure social distancing guidelines are followed
- PPE for SNP Staff and provide daily temperature checks before entering the kitchen



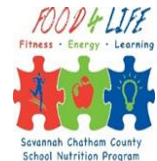
Model 2

Virtual Learning at Home- All Grade Levels

- Meals prepared at each school site and delivered by bus routes attached to that site (Deliver breakfast and lunch at the same time -multiple meals and multiple days)
- Ask state department to remain under COVID-19 status (all meals will be at no cost to students)
- No offer-versus serve (some meals can be prepared for heat at home with instructions)
- Deliver entire meal in t-shirt bags
- Deploy staff from smaller schools on bus to help with meal distribution and accountability
- PPE for SNP Staff and provide daily temperature checks before entering the kitchen

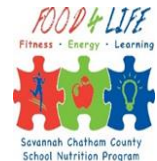
2 Days Inside School Building and 3 days Virtual Learning at Home

2 Days inside building

- Timeframe to serve breakfast and lunch in classroom to lengthen instructional time
- Prepackaged meals: no offer-versus serve
- Ask state department to remain under COVID-19 status (all meals will be at no cost to students)
- Class attendance daily to know how many meals to prepare if eating in classroom
- Deliver entire meal in t-shirt bags
- If serving hot meals, need mobile electric holding cabinets
- All employees will deploy meals to classrooms

- No offer-versus serve (some meals can be prepared for heat at home with instructions)
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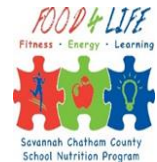
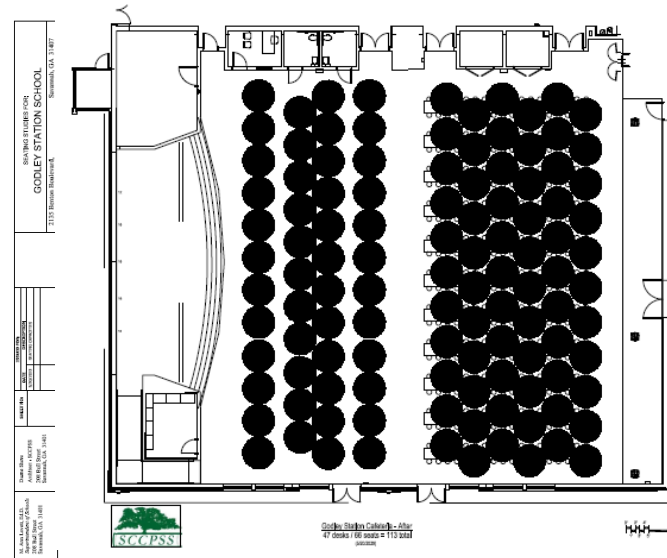
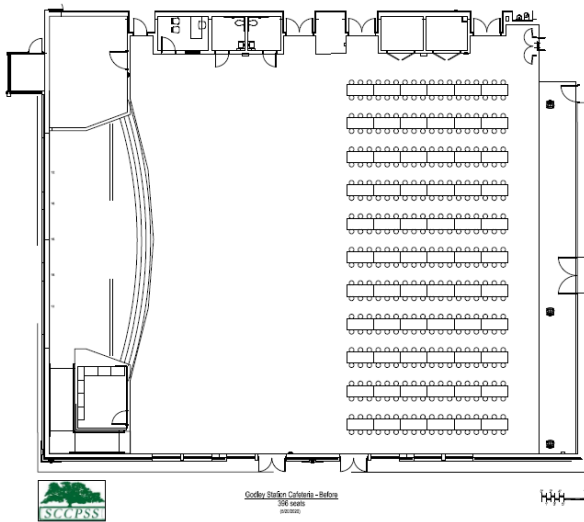
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Seating Arrangements for Godley K-8 Cafeteria
 Normal seating = 396 Students

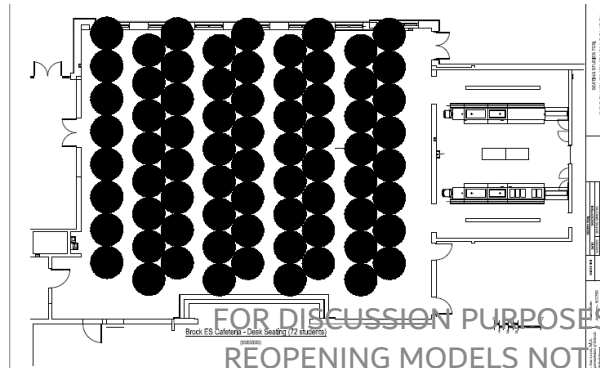
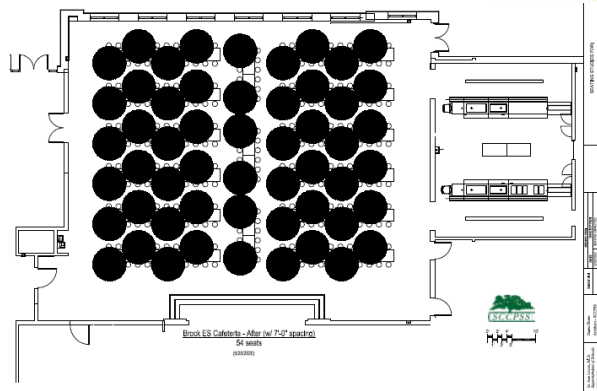
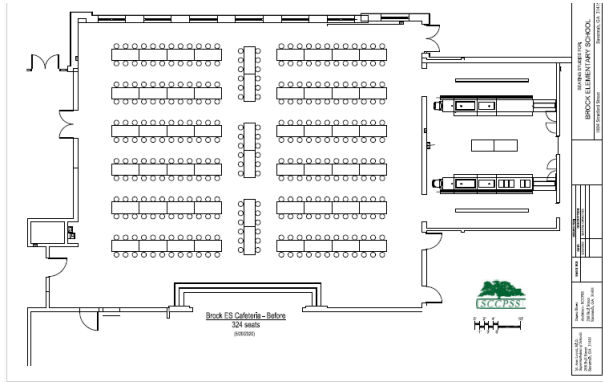
COVID-19 Seating with combination of existing tables and desks = 113 Students



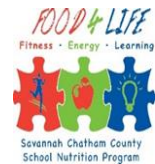
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Seating Arrangements for Brock ES Cafeteria

 COVID-19 Seating with desks = 72

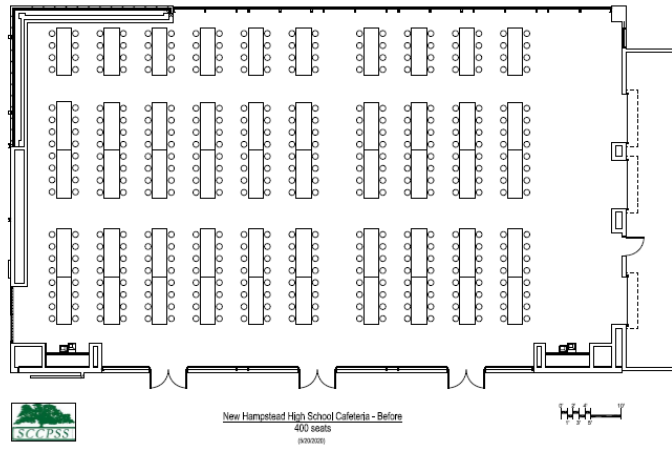


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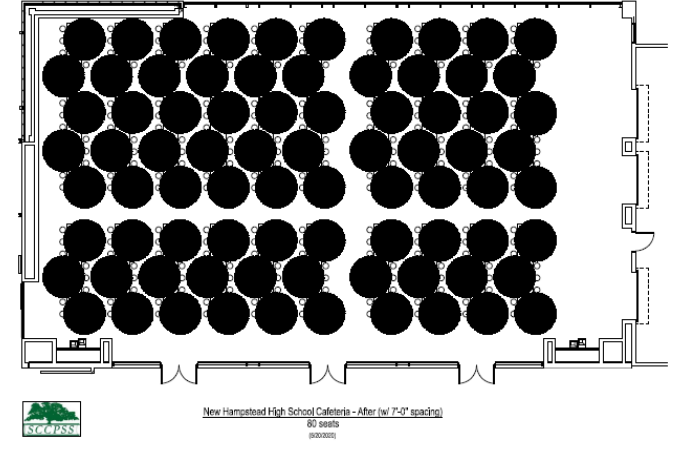




Seating Arrangements for NHHS Cafeteria

 COVID-19 Seating with existing tables = 80 Students



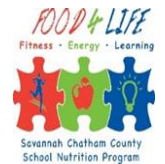

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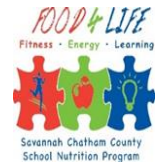


Areas of Concern

- Distribution, collection and processing of meal applications
- Collection of meal payments if Covid-19 free eligibility waiver is not extended for SY 2020-2021
- Students that bring meals from home-will this be allowed?
- Accommodating high-risk employees(Equates to over half of the School Nutrition Staff)
- Staff schedule work hours may need to be extended (Additional salaries)
- Equipment needed if serving in classroom i.e., cooler bags, mobile electric heating cabinets for hot meals, carts for transport
- When to place order for food, cleaning supplies, and disposables for deliveries when staff is not present at sites
