	<b>Question</b>	<b>Response</b>
<b>1.</b>	Does Bid #15-82 require a Bid Bond or Performance Bond?	No.
<b>2.</b>	During the pre-bid meeting it was stated that the landscape company that gets the landscape maintenance on the schools also will get the initial one-time cleanup of the property (if needed) and the price would be negotiated. The responsibility of the cleanup would not be awarded to one company on other company's job. Is this still correct?	<p>Yes.            The award of the contract will be based on the monthly cost. The school district reserves the right to award to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder which is determined to be in the best interest of the District. The District reserves the right to split the award of this solicitation.</p> <p>The District reserves the right to negotiate the one-time cleanup cost with the awarded vendor for the site.</p>
<b>3.</b>	If so, then if a company does not bid the initial one-time cleanup on a particular campus would they be awarded the landscape maintenance for that campus?	<p>Initial one-time cleanup cost shall be submitted for each site that your firm is submitting a cost for monthly service.</p> <p>The initial one-time cleanup cost is option pricing that will be negotiated and authorized if within the District's budget.</p>
<b>4.</b>	Upon estimating the school bid this week and seeing pine straw missing in areas I am asking the School District to consider line item pricing for maintenance, pine straw, and turf/shrub chemical for each property so the School District would have a better understanding of how the vendors arrived at their final pricing. This would move away from Addendum #1 pricing for just a lump monthly cost and annual cost.	<p>Bidders shall provide a monthly cost for each site which must include all services as outlined in Section 24.0 Scope of Services, Items A-L.</p> <p>Bidders shall submit their pricing on the Bid Submittal Form provided with Addendum #1.</p>
