Addendum No. 2 is issued answer questions submitted prior to the inquiry deadline. The questions and answers are as follows:

No.	Questions	Answers
1.	Have these services been done before? If so, what was the price paid for these services?	Yes, this is an annual contract. See attached current pricing.
2.	On the requirements for service, there is a stipulation that states the provider must treat the perimeter up to 20' of the schools. Is that a definite requirement because typically a lawn and ornamental license is required for any treatments beyond 3'.	Based on Rules and Regulations of the State of Georgia Rule 620-11-.01 Treatment of Schools  Pesticide applications may be made to outdoor school grounds if children or students are not expected to be present within (20) feet of the application site at the time of application except as specified in Rule 620-11-.01 (1)(e). These areas must be clearly marked to discourage entry and secured by a fence or other similar barrier stating the reentry interval. If the application site is not secured by a fence or other similar barrier, pesticide applications may be made to an outdoor school ground only if children or students are not expected to be in the area for a minimum of (3) hours after application.
3.	What is the height requirement for treatment for wasps nests on the side of buildings? Anything above 15' requires a lift and an extra charge for treatment and removal of the nests.	Please provide the rental cost for the lift and additional charges for services on the revised bid submittal attached.
