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What Is A School Compact?

A school compact is a written agreement between a school, its parents and students. The compact gives strategies to help support students' success in school.

The compact explains what families and schools can do to make a connection for the student between the two "worlds" they live in, home and school.

Families were involved in the development of the compact through the Family Forum, surveys and feedback from meetings. This becomes the compact that is signed as an agreement by all those involved in the child's education.

How Will We Communicate?

It is very important for the school and parents to communicate on a regular basis in order to build the bridge between school and home. At Haven we will communicate by:

- ◆ Sending home communication folders.
- ◆ Utilizing the school's "call-out" system to deliver messages via phone as well as email.
- ◆ Planning parent/teacher conferences to update parents on student successes and areas of need and the discussion of school compacts.
- ◆ Informing parents about the ability to check on their child's grades through Parent Portal and Power School.
- ◆ By keeping the school website up to date.
- ◆ Using communication apps: Remind and Class Dojo
- ◆ Teachers will make weekly phone calls, send text messages and emails to parents where necessary.

Teaming Up for Success: School, Parents, Students



School input in student success is the third leg of the success triangle. The school team and parents decided the following were needed from the school to help promote success.

- ◆ Supply students with reading materials on their level to take home to read.
- ◆ Send home sight words for student to practice with parents weekly. Use sight words in lessons and activities daily.
- ◆ Send home resources to assist students with learning basic addition and subtraction facts. Provide time to practice facts in class.

Students play the biggest role in their own success. Haven Hornets gave ideas and feedback about what was important to them to be successful in school. Students gave the following ideas:

- ◆ Read with my parent or family member for 30 minutes daily.
- ◆ Practice and master sight words.
- ◆ Practice math facts to 20 (addition and subtraction).

Parents joined Haven staff to develop a list of actions to support student success.

- ◆ Read aloud with my child for 30 minutes daily.
- ◆ Review sight words daily.
- ◆ Practice math facts to 20 (addition and subtraction).
