

## iReady Info for parents

Our gators will take the End of the Year iReady Diagnostic between March 25<sup>th</sup> and April 26<sup>th</sup>. You are receiving the results for their last diagnostic. Our school wide goal for this year is 27% of our Gators will meet their annual stretch growth in Reading and 25% of our Gators will meet their annual stretch growth in math by the end of the year. There are also grade level goals. Stretch Growth - This is a higher goal. If your child is a bit behind, this goal aims to help them catch up. And if your child is doing just fine or even ahead, this goal challenges them to learn even more and become really good at what they're doing.
